The 2022 season kicked off at Marvel field with the Endicott Gulls coming down for a preseason friendly. Unfortunately, despite being physical and aggressive, Endicott was not able to convert any of their possessions into points. Nine of our own players scored throughout the day with Pablo Lavilla, Keigo Hachisuka and

William Zeller scoring twice each. Sophomore Max O'Donahue ran four tries on his own to be the top try scorer on the day however Dylan Lewis' 83% conversion rate (13 conversions), along with a try of his own, placed him as the top points scorer.

Both halves were fairly balanced in terms of scoring with 47 points being scored in the first half and 54 in the second. Endicott's best scoring opportunity came off a blocked clearing kick deep in Brown's red zone. Full credit goes to the Bears for working hard after the blocked kick as they were able to hold up the opposition just over the line and win a goal line drop out to get us out of trouble.

Five freshmen made their debut for the first side on this day with Henrique Gabriel starting at loosehead prop then moving to backrow, Tony Zhao came in as a lock replacement, Kaspar Pitblado started at back row but was replaced by Jimmy Phelan, and Cameron McAlpine started at backrow as well.

This upcoming Saturday, Brown travels to Syracuse University in NY for two matches. The first match will kick off off at 1:00 P.M. It is unknown if the game will be live streamed at this time.
